



MIDWEST MODERN-TRIMMED CLEANING CLOTHS



This simple pattern is made from a set of rectangles. You can use scraps left over from other pillow or quilting projects to brighten up your cleaning.

You'll need:

- Cotton or microfiber terry cloth, one rectangle 14 inches by 7 inches.
- Amy Butler cotton print (or other fun fabric), two rectangles 7 inches by 5 inches.



To make:

- Plan your trims to center main design elements.
- Sew trim pieces to short edges of terry cloth.
- Press seam toward trim.
- Turn other edge, press and top stitch.



Then:

- Fold the cleaning cloth in half so that the decorative bands align.
- With right sides together, stitch the sides of the cleaning cloth.
- Turn right side out and press.



Voila!

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
